Small heroes in trouble – Boys searching for their identities

Target group

TEACHERS (pre-school, primary, secondary, vocational, adult, special needs) and TEACHER TRAINERS

Programme

Preparation:

This In-Service training course is a result of the COMENIUS project "Small heroes in trouble – Boys searching for their identities" and takes part during the third year of this continuing project. The project is based on the fact that it is clear from social developments in recent years that boys are increasingly a focus of critical attention and of concern to educationalists. Through the project the ten partner institutions addressed what is currently a theme of growing importance, namely the gender-specific dimension in children's education and upbringing.

The participants of the course are asked to be able to reflect on the gender specific situation in the classroom in their countries. Be able to explain experiences, conflicts and problems when teaching boys and girls.

Objectives:

The partner institutions aimed to develop a research-based body of study material, as well as a series of modules on both the practice and the educational methodology of teachers' work, that will add a gender-specific dimension to co-educational schooling in Europe. The outcomes of two years intensive work on this topic are course texts ("Pedagogical Approaches to Learning and Teaching with Boys – A European Perspective") Including a comparative study in both web-based and published form. The educational (-methodology) modules cover theory and practical approaches and are available in web-based form.

Within this In-Service training course the developed material (study material as well as a series of modules) will be tested, evaluated and disseminated.

Methodology:

Within the course several methodologies will be used: Interaction and discussions, exploration of materials (texts, comparative study, modules), experimenting with new ideas, case studies, training based on the developed material, concrete examples of good practice, practicing new skills,...

Outcomes:

The participants will be acquainted with knowledge/ skills about:

- Gender education in general
- Approaches to learning and teaching with boys
- The situation about learning and teaching with boys in Europe
- Concrete examples to work with boys on topics like: body and health, sexuality, identity and self concepts, aggressions, special needs and culture
- To use different instruments like: games and exercises
- To work around emotions and socialemotional wellbeing


